## Siberian

While considered a semi-longhair, the Siberian's coat varies with the season. In the winter, it will have a thick, rich, fit that would have protected it from the elements in its native Russia. In the summer, they shed the heavy winter coat for a dense coat. They come in a wide variety of colors and patterns, including pointed, with deep intense colors and rich patterns that make them a dramatic stand out from the everyday cat. Siberians are a strong, powerfully built cat with strong hind legs that jump exceptionally high. They are a slow-maturing breed reaching full magnificence at about 5 years of age.
